Best Start

The Best Start Kindergarten Assessment evaluates students' literacy and numeracy skills upon entry to kindergarten. All kindergarten students undergo literacy and numeracy assessments within the first five weeks of school. This assessment has been implemented in all NSW public schools since 2010. It is aligned with the National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progressions. The assessment is integrated into existing school practices, complementing teaching and learning programs that support students' transition to school. Kindergarten assessments are scheduled to take place during week 5.

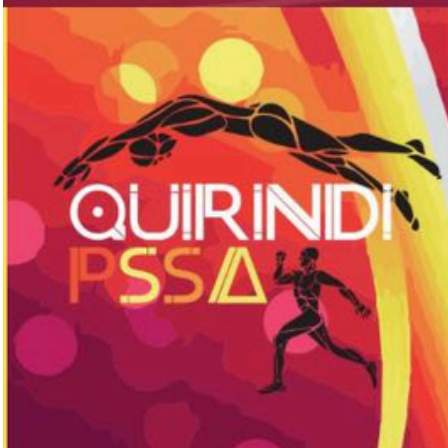

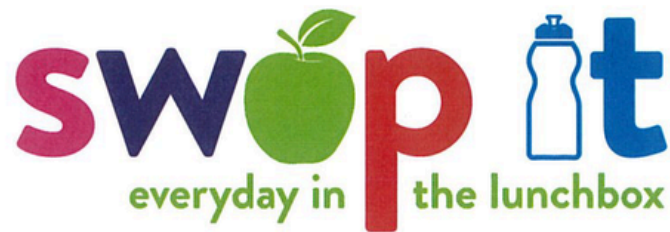

Add a splash of rainbow

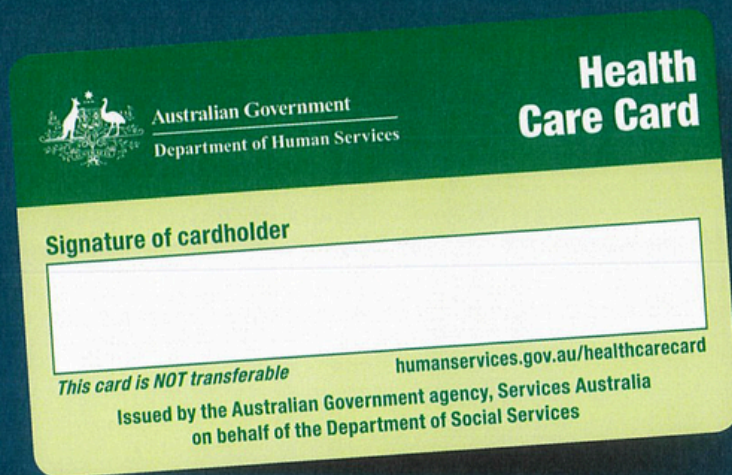
Wow your kids by making everyday lunchboxes fun, colourful and appealing. Lots of colour means lots of different vitamins and minerals.
